LIMITED LIFETIME POOL COVER WARRANTY
MIGHTY MESH

Rayner Covering Systems, Inc. will warrant to the original purchaser at the original installation only, that the Rayner Covering Safety Mesh or Solid Vinyl Pool Cover is free from defects in material or workmanship. If, upon our inspection, a damaged cover falls within our warranty criteria, we will repair or replace at our option, at no charge, if the damage occurs within 60 months of it's factory ship date.

After 60 months have passed, there is a prorated charge for each month thereafter beginning from date of purchase of 1/360 of the current price of repair or replacement of the cover plus a 10% service and handling charge.

Rayner Covering Systems, Inc. warrants to the original purchaser for which the cover was originally installed that it shall be at our discretion to determine whether the cover has failed under normal use, service, or conditions and whether it occurred within ten years of the original purchase date.

The warranty is void if:

- A rectangular cover has been put on a non-rectangular pool.
• The cover was damaged due to improper installation.
• The cover was subject to misuse, alteration, neglect, abuse, accident, Act of God, or damage caused by animal(s).
• The water level of the pool falls below 18 inches from the top of the pool during the snow season.
• More than 10% of anchor positions are lawn stakes or more than 30% are short springs.
• Areas not using straps with springs (i.e. using grommets and anchors only) exceeds 10% of the cover.
• Too much water or snow left on cover causing damage.

All repairs and replacements are F.O.B. Rayner's plant and Rayner shall not be responsible for any freight charges, installation, service or labor charges.

This warranty is in lieu of any other warranty, expressed or implied, and of all other obligation or liabilities on our part and we do not assume or authorize any person to assume for any other obligation or liability.

Pool Cover Care
With proper care, your Rayner Pool cover can last many years.

How to Clean your Pool Cover

- Clean pool cover using mild detergent and a soft broom.
• DO NOT use a pressure washer to clean cover.

General Care

- Do not allow children or pets to play on cover.
• Do not drag your cover across deck surface.
• Do not allow the water in the pool to fall below 18" from top of pool during snow season.
• Spring tension prior to snow load should not be compressed more than 1/2.
• Do not pour pool chemicals through mesh material.
• Do not allow water to stand on vinyl covers. Any standing water must be pumped off immediately.
• Any punctures or tears in cover should be repaired immediately to retain safety.
• Do not burn rubbish or leaves near pool cover.

Storage

- Cover should be stored clean and dry.
• Spring covers should be left on the cover during storage to protect against damage by the springs.
• Cover should be stored in the mesh bag away from moisture and rodents (preferably hung).
